Level 3 requires organizations to implement 130 practices. At this level, organizations must demonstrate that they can protect CUI effectively. This includes more advanced practices in risk management and incident response.

CMMC Level 4: Proactive Cyber Hygiene

Level 4 emphasizes proactive measures to protect against advanced persistent threats (APTs). Organizations must implement 156 practices and demonstrate a strong capability for threat hunting and incident response.

CMMC Level 5: Advanced Cyber Hygiene

Level 5 is the most stringent level, requiring 171 practices. Organizations at this level must demonstrate an advanced cybersecurity posture and resilience against sophisticated cyber threats.

The CMMC Assessment Process

Pre-Assessment
