THESE DISPLACED FAMILIES FACED DISCRIMINATION AND HARDSHIP IN THEIR NEW LOCATIONS, AS THEY STRUGGLED TO FIND WORK AND ESTABLISH NEW LIVES.

GOVERNMENT RESPONSE AND POLICY CHANGES

IN RESPONSE TO THE DUST BOWL, THE U.S. GOVERNMENT ENACTED SEVERAL POLICIES AIMED AT MITIGATING THE DISASTER AND PREVENTING FUTURE OCCURRENCES. PROGRAMS INTRODUCED DURING THIS PERIOD INCLUDED:
