THIS VILLANELLE IS PERHAPS THOMAS'S MOST FAMOUS POEM. IT EXPLORES THEMES OF RESISTANCE AGAINST DEATH AND THE STRUGGLE FOR LIFE. THE REPEATED REFRAINS SERVE TO EMPHASIZE THE URGENCY OF LIVING FULLY, MAKING IT AN APPROPRIATE REFLECTION ON ONE'S BIRTHDAY, A CELEBRATION OF LIFE ITSELF.

"FERN HILL"

"FERN HILL" IS A NOSTALGIC RECOLLECTION OF CHILDHOOD AND THE PASSAGE OF TIME. THE POEM'S RICH IMAGERY EVOKES THE INNOCENCE AND JOY OF YOUTH, CONTRASTING WITH THE INEVITABILITY OF GROWING OLDER. IT SERVES AS A BEAUTIFUL REMINDER OF THE FLEETING NATURE OF LIFE, MAKING IT ESPECIALLY RELEVANT ON BIRTHDAYS.
