THIS CULTURAL EDUCATION FOSTERS GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP AND ENHANCES INTERPERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS AMONG INDIVIDUALS OF DIFFERENT BACKGROUNDS.

LEVELS OF PROFICIENCY IN ESOL

4. **B2 (UPPER INTERMEDIATE):** LEARNERS CAN UNDERSTAND THE MAIN IDEAS OF COMPLEX TEXTS AND INTERACT WITH A DEGREE OF FLUENCY.
5. **C1 (ADVANCED):** LEARNERS CAN UNDERSTAND A WIDE RANGE OF DEMANDING, LONGER TEXTS AND EXPRESS THEMSELVES FLUENTLY AND SPONTANEOUSLY.
6. **C2 (PROFICIENT):** LEARNERS CAN UNDERSTAND WITH EASE VIRTUALLY EVERYTHING HEARD OR READ AND SUMMARIZE INFORMATION FROM DIFFERENT SPOKEN AND WRITTEN SOURCES.

THIS PROFICIENCY FRAMEWORK ALLOWS ESOL LEARNERS TO SET ACHIEVABLE GOALS AND MEASURE THEIR PROGRESS EFFECTIVELY.

TEACHING METHODOLOGIES IN ESOL

EFFECTIVE ESOL TEACHING METHODOLOGIES ARE ESSENTIAL FOR FACILITATING LANGUAGE ACQUISITION. VARIOUS APPROACHES CAN BE EMPLOYED, DEPENDING ON THE LEARNERS' NEEDS AND CONTEXTS. SOME OF THE MOST WIDELY USED METHODOLOGIES INCLUDE:
