4. **CONFORMITY:** PROPOSED BY SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGIST SOLOMON ASCH, CONFORMITY REFERS TO THE TENDENCY OF INDIVIDUALS TO CHANGE THEIR BEHAVIOR OR BELIEFS TO MATCH THOSE OF A GROUP, EVEN IF THEY DISAGREE INTERNALLY.

IMPLICATIONS OF HERD MENTALITY

HERD MENTALITY CAN HAVE FAR-REACHING EFFECTS IN VARIOUS DOMAINS, INCLUDING FINANCE, POLITICS, MARKETING, AND SOCIAL BEHAVIOR.

FINANCIAL MARKETS

POLITICS AND VOTING BEHAVIOR
