JOAN OF ARC

HER LEADERSHIP AND VICTORIES INSPIRED FRENCH TROOPS, AND SHE BECAME A SYMBOL OF FRENCH UNITY AND NATIONALISM. JOAN WAS EVENTUALLY CAPTURED AND EXECUTED, BUT HER LEGACY ENDURES AS A NATIONAL HEROINE AND A SAINT.

CULTURAL DEVELOPMENTS
