FOR INSTANCE, THE **SHOFAR**, A RAM'S HORN USED IN JEWISH RELIGIOUS PRACTICES, EXEMPLIFIES HOW DIFFERENT SOCIETIES UTILIZED NATURAL RESOURCES TO CREATE WIND INSTRUMENTS.

DEVELOPMENT THROUGH THE AGES

THE DEVELOPMENT OF BRASS INSTRUMENTS ADVANCED SIGNIFICANTLY DURING THE MIDDLE AGES AND THE RENAISSANCE.
