ORIGINS OF HAIGHT-ASHBURY

THE INFLUENCE OF BEAT CULTURE

BEAT CULTURE PLAYED A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN SHAPING THE SOCIAL LANDSCAPE OF HAIGHT-ASHBURY. FIGURES SUCH AS JACK KEROUAC AND ALLEN GINSBERG INSPIRED A GENERATION TO QUESTION SOCIETAL NORMS. THE SUMMER OF LOVE

INFLUENTIAL FIGURES
