Goblin - Rocketry and Will (if available in chosen WotLK version)

If Goblins are an option in your WotLK Classic experience, their Rocket Barrage and Rocket Jump abilities offer utility and mobility, which can be beneficial for almost any class, particularly those focused on ranged damage or needing an escape. Their Gold Rush passive also aids in acquiring more gold, useful for gear and consumables.

Essential Leveling Tools and Addons
