INNER CIRCLE BAD BOYS THEME FROM COPS LYRICS HAS BECOME AN ICONIC REPRESENTATION OF THE GENRE OF POLICE-THEMED ENTERTAINMENT. THE BAND'S HISTORY DATES BACK TO THE 1960S, BUT IT WAS THE RELEASE OF "BAD BOYS" THAT CATAPULTED THEM INTO THE MAINSTREAM. THEIR MUSIC OFTEN EXPLORES THEMES OF REBELLION, LOVE, AND SOCIAL ISSUES, WHICH ARE REFLECTED IN THE LYRICS OF "BAD BOYS." INFLUENCE ON MUSIC AND MEDIA
