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Understanding Jing Yuan's Role and Kit

Best Light Cones for Jing Yuan

Choosing the right Light Cone is paramount for Jing Yuan's damage ceiling. The best-in-slot options focus on increasing his raw damage, critical rate, and critical damage, as well as providing buffs to his attacks.

Best-in-Slot Light Cones

- **Before Dawn:** This signature Light Cone for Jing Yuan is his undisputed best. It significantly boosts his CRIT DMG, increases Skill and Ultimate DMG, and grants a chance to inflict Convert damage after using his Ultimate. The synergy with his kit is unparalleled.
- **The Birth of the Self:** While more accessible and often a strong choice for Destruction characters, this Light Cone is excellent for Jing Yuan if Before Dawn is unavailable. Strong Alternative Light Cones

- **Today is Another Day:** This Battle Pass Light Cone provides a substantial ATK% bonus that increases over time as allies fall, making it a solid option for sustained damage.
- **Collapsing Sky:** A readily available 3-star Light Cone, Collapsing Sky offers a flat damage bonus to his attacks, which can be surprisingly effective in the early to mid-game. It's a good placeholder until better options are acquired.

Top Relic Sets and Main/Sub-Stats

Relic sets and their associated main and sub-stats are critical for optimizing Jing Yuan's performance. The goal is to stack as much CRIT Rate, CRIT DMG, and ATK% as possible, with a special emphasis on SPD for the Lightning Lord.

Best-in-Slot Relic Sets

- **4-Piece Lightning: Thundering Set:** This set is tailor-made for Jing Yuan. Two pieces grant a 10% Lightning DMG Bonus, and four pieces increase his CRIT DMG by 20% against enemies with Shock. Furthermore, it grants an additional 10% CRIT DMG when the target is Shocked. This set directly amplifies his primary damage type and synergizes perfectly with his abilities.
- **2-Piece Musketeer of Wild Wheat + 2-Piece Lightning: Thundering Set:** If you are struggling to acquire a full 4-piece Thundering set or need specific sub-stats, this combination is a very strong alternative. The 2-piece Musketeer grants 5% ATK, while the 2-piece Thundering provides the Lightning DMG Bonus, offering a balanced approach to his damage output.

Recommended Main Stats

- **Body:** CRIT Rate or CRIT DMG (whichever is lower to reach a 1:2 ratio, aiming for at least 70% CRIT Rate)
- **Feet:** SPD or ATK% (SPD is generally preferred to increase the frequency of Lightning Lord attacks)
- **Planar Sphere:** Lightning DMG Bonus
- **Link Rope:** ATK%

Key Sub-Stats to Prioritize

- **CRIT Rate:** Essential for consistent damage.
- **CRIT DMG:** Directly amplifies his critical hits.

Recommended Team Compositions

Jing Yuan thrives in teams that can support his damage output, provide buffs, and enable him to get more turns. Synergy is key.
